11/9/14 – The Promise Keeper (Joshua 24:1-3, 14-25, Matthew 25:1-13) God's covenant promises involve blessings for faithfulness and destruction for breaking the covenant. It is never God that breaks the covenant; it is always humans that break the covenant. Yet, in grace God sent Jesus to fulfill the covenant for us when we could not keep it ourselves. A thankful response to God's covenant faithfulness for us is to be faithful to our commitment to serve God.

11/16/14 – Pastor Scott was fulfilling his duties for the Classis, supervising the Pinelands Reformed Church. In his place, Rev. Keith Ross, director of the Rutgers Native American Welcome Center and a member of the Cree Tribe filled our pulpit.

11/23/14 – We Are His (Psalm 100, Ephesians 1:15-23, Matthew 25:31-46) Like lost sheep, we once were lost and alone. God chose us as His people and went to the ends of the earth to find us and bring us home. It is sometimes easy for us to forget what an amazing concept it is that we are children of the King of Creation.





Filmed on location at Sepphoris outside of Nazareth.


